

ATTENTION VOTERS IN THE 8TH WARD – CITY OF BEAVER DAM

A vacancy exists in the 8th Ward due to the election of Rebecca Glewen as Mayor. Applications from interested persons to complete her term will be accepted until 4:30 p.m., Thursday, May 11, 2017.

The appointment expires at midnight on April 16, 2018. Individuals interested in filling a two-year term as the Eight Ward Alderperson may then seek that position by circulating nomination papers and running for election in the spring of 2018.

For interested individuals, Ward 8 is bordered by the Corporate Limits east of USH 151 along Prospect Avenue, N. Crystal Lake Road, and CTH E; the 500 block of E. Burnett Street; the 700 block of McKinley Street; the 100 and 200 blocks of Charlton Street; the 700 and 800 blocks of N. University Avenue; the 100 and blocks of Bogert Street; the 300 block of McKinley Street; the 500 and 600 blocks of Gould Street; and the westerly right-of-way of USH 151 to Prospect Avenue.

Interested applicants may contact the Contact the City Clerk's office in the Municipal Building, 205 S. Lincoln Avenue, Beaver Dam for a Ward map or a complete listing of properties located within Ward 8. Interested applicants should also stop at the City Clerk's office to submit a letter of interest and sign a declaration of candidacy during the regular business hours of Monday thru Friday from 7:30 a.m. to noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
