

**City of Beaver Dam**  
**Administrative Committee Minutes**  
**April 16, 2018**

Chairperson Davidson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were, Anderson, Nelson, Burnett Appenfeldt, Flaherty and Hansen. Also present for all or parts of the meeting were City Attorney Schacht, Mayor Glewen, Police Chief Kreuziger, Alderpersons Loizzo, Doyle, Abfall, Ballweg & Fischer, several members of the public, Craig Warmbold (WBEV/WXRO) and Chris Higgins (Daily Citizen).

Motion by Burnett, second by Flaherty to approve the minutes from the April 2, 2018 Administrative Committee meeting, carried by acclamation.

After presentation and discussion of same motion by Flaherty, second by Burnett to recommend approval of a resolution to hire Danny Mulhern for the position of Public Works Supervisor, carried by acclamation.

After presentation and discussion of same motion by Hansen, second by Nelson to recommend approval of a resolution granting Beverage Operator license number 229, carried by acclamation.

After presentation and discussion of same motion by Nelson, second by Hansen to recommend approval of a resolution to appropriate a donation in the amount of \$500.00 from Northwoods Casket Company, carried by acclamation.

The committee considered five possible options to replace the City's current noise ordinance. In summary all five options prohibit loud, disturbing and unnecessary noises in the City at all times and also prohibits certain types of noise during "nighttime" hours. The differences between the five options are as follows:

- Option #1 – Nighttime hours would be 10:00 pm to 6:00 am every day.
- Option #2 – Nighttime hours would be 11:00 pm to 6:00 am every day.
- Option #3 – Nighttime hours would be 11:00 pm to 6:00 am on Friday and Saturday and 10:00 pm – 6:00 am the remaining days of the week.
- Option #4 – Nighttime hours would be 11:00 pm to 6:00 am on Saturday and 10:00 pm – 6:00 am the remaining days of the week.
- Option #5 – Has no provision for nighttime hours and would prohibit outdoor music unless a permit was obtained.

After a lengthy discussion of the pros and cons of all options motion by Flaherty, second by Burnett to endorse option #2 and recommend the same to the Common Council was approved by a vote of 4 ayes, 2 noes (Appenfeldt and Anderson) and 1 abstention (Hansen).

Motion by Flaherty, second by Burnett to adjourn at 7:31 pm, carried by acclamation.
