

Downloading **NetLibrary** eBooks to Your Portable Device

Before you download you will need . . .

- A **compatible portable eReader device**, such the Barnes and Noble Nook, a Sony Digital Reader, or any device that supports the Adobe Content Server. NOTE: At this time the Amazon Kindle is NOT compatible with NetLibrary eBooks
- **Adobe Digital Editions 1.7.1** installed and activated on your computer. It is available free of charge at www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/
- An **Adobe ID**, available free of charge from www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership

Notes:

- Both your eReader and your computer must be authorized with the same Adobe ID.
- At this time the **Amazon Kindle is NOT compatible with NetLibrary eBooks**

Check out and download to your person computer. . .

1. Log in to your **NetLibrary Account** or create a NetLibrary account
(www.cityofbeaverdam.com/library → Downloads → NetLibrary → Create a free Account).
2. Browse or search for an eBook that you want to download.
3. Click the **Show Details** link for the title to view the eBook Details page.
4. Click **Check Out & Download this eBook**.
5. Click the **Download this eContent** button on the Download this eContent page.
6. Click **Open** in the file download box that appears. The eBook will download and open in Adobe Digital Editions. The eBook PDF file is saved to the My Digital Editions folder in the My Documents folder on your computer.
7. Enjoy reading the eBook in Adobe Digital Editions.

Transfer an eBook to a portable device . . .

After you download an eBook to your computer, you can transfer it to a compatible portable device.

1. Connect your compatible eReader device to your computer.
2. Locate the device icon in the left hand menu in Adobe Digital Editions.
3. In Library View, drag the eBook title to the icon.

Downloading **OverDrive** eBooks to Your Portable Device

Before you download you will need . . .

Check out and download to your person computer. . .

1. **Sign in to Overdrive** by selecting **Mid-Wisconsin** and using your **Library Card # and PIN*** (www.cityofbeaverdam.com/library → Downloads → OverDrive→ Sign In)
*Your PIN number can be obtained by bring your library card to the Beaver Dam Community Library
2. Browse or search for an eBook that you want to download.
3. Click the **Add to My Cart** to add the title to your cart for checkout.
4. From your cart, click **Proceed to Checkout**.
5. Select a lending period of 7 or 14 days and click **Confirm check out**
6. Click the green **Download** button to download the book to your computer
7. Select **Open With Adobe Digital Editions** and click **OK**. The eBook will download and open in Adobe Digital Editions.
8. Enjoy reading the eBook in Adobe Digital Editions.
