The appointment expires in April, 2018. Individuals interested in filling a two-year term as the TENTH Ward Alderperson may then seek that position by circulating nomination papers and running for election in the spring of 2018.

For those interested Individuals City of Beaver Dam Ward 10 is bordered as described below;

Commencing at the intersection of the Westerly right-of-way of USH 151 and the centerline of Gould Street, being the Point of Beginning; thence westerly along the centerline of Gould Street to the centerline of McKinley Street; thence southerly to the centerline of Prospect Avenue; thence westerly to the centerline of N. University Avenue; thence southeasterly to the centerline of Park Avenue; thence westerly to the centerline of S. Vita Avenue; thence southerly to the centerline of E. Mill Street; thence easterly to the centerline of Roosevelt Drive; thence southerly to the centerline of E. South Street; thence easterly to the east property lines of the 500 and 600 blocks of Monroe Street; thence southerly along said east property lines to the westerly right-of-way of USH 151; thence northerly along said westerly right-of-way of USH 151 to the Point of Beginning.

Interested applicants should also submit a letter of interest and sign a declaration of candidacy during the regular business hours of Monday thru Friday from 7:30 a.m. to noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
