5. Confirmation of appropriate Board of Review and Open Meetings notices.
6. Receipt of the Assessment Roll by Clerk from the Assessor.
7. Receive the Assessment roll and sworn statements from the Clerk.
8. Assessor Summary.
9. Verify that the City has an ordinance for the confidentiality of income and expense information provided to the assessor under state law (sec. 70.47(7)(af)).
10. Allow Taxpayers to examine assessment data.
11. Consideration of requests for waiver of the 48-hour notice of intent to file an objection when there is good cause.
12. Consider requests for waiver of BOR hearing allowing the property owner to appeal directly to the circuit court.
13. Consider requests to testify by telephone or submit sworn written statement.
14. Consider subpoena requests.
15. Act on any other legally allowed/required BOR matters.
16. Review Notices of Intent to File Objection.
17. Proceed to hear objections, if any, and if proper notice/waivers given unless scheduled for another date.
18. Consider/act on scheduling additional BOR meeting date(s).
19. Adjourn (to a future date if necessary).
