The appointment expires in April 2023. Individuals interested in completing a two-year term as the THIRD Ward Alderperson may then seek that position by circulating nomination papers and running for election in the spring of 2023.

For those interested Individuals City of Beaver Dam Ward 3 is bordered as described below:

Commencing at the intersection of Oneida Street and Mary Street, being the Point of Beginning; thence southerly along the centerline of Mary Street to the centerline of West Maple Avenue; thence easterly along the centerline of West Maple Avenue to the centerline of West Street; thence southerly along the centerline of West Street to the centerline of Haskell Street; thence northeasterly along the centerline of Haskell Street to the centerline of Beaver Street; thence southerly along the centerline of Beaver Street to the centerline of the Beaver Dam River; thence easterly and continuing southerly along the centerline of the Beaver Dam River to the centerline extended of Pearl Street; thence northwesterly along the centerline of Pearl Street to the centerline of South Center Street; thence northeasterly along the centerline of South Center Street to the centerline of Chatham Street; thence northwesterly along the centerline of Chatham Street to the centerline of Madison Street; thence southwesterly along the centerline of Madison Street to the centerline of East Water Street; thence northwesterly along the centerline of East Water Street to the shoreline of Beaver Dam Lake; thence northeasterly along the shoreline of Beaver Dam Lake to the centerline extended of Greenwich Street; thence westerly to the City of Beaver Dam corporate limits; thence northerly along the City of Beaver Dam corporate limits to the centerline extended of Oneida Street; thence easterly along the centerline extended of Oneida Street to the shoreline of Beaver Dam Lake; thence continuing easterly along the centerline of Oneida Street to the centerline of Mary Street and the Point of Beginning.
