Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard, Card Stock, Office Paper, Books, Envelopes, Paper</p> <p>Other Examples: Brown Paper Tape, Computer Printouts, File Folders-Manila, Glued Pads, Tablets, Phone Books, Post-It Notes, and ANY Junk Mail</p>	<p>What can't be recycled? Bathroom Waste Paper (towels, toilet paper), Carbon Paper, Cellophane, Cloth, Cork, Foil, Polystyrene Styrofoam, anything Waxed, Candy Wrappers, Napkins, Paper Cups, Styrofoam Cups, Styrofoam Packaging, Paper Food Containers, Photographs, Fiberboard, Labels and Label Backings, Shredded Paper</p>	

Recycling Rules:

- ✓ **All Recycling items** listed above, **will be collected every other week** (see calendar on reverse side) and include glass, aluminum, tin and steel cans, plastics, cardboard, paper and magazines, which shall be mixed together in contractor provided recycling cart ONLY.
 - ✓ **All other materials** shall be placed in the non-recyclable (garbage) cart ONLY.

NOTE: CART MUST FACE THE STREET AS INDICATED BY ARROW ON CART, MUST BE FULLY ACCESSIBLE AND NOT BLOCKED BY PARKED VEHICLES. CARTS MUST BE AT LEAST 3 FT. APART AND AT LEAST 3 FT. FROM ANY OTHER OBJECT (mail box, tree, etc.).
